Your child can say key vocabulary words in Spanish such as Hola, Adiós, por favor, gracias and can speak small conversational phrases in Spanish including: ¿Cómo te llamas? Me llamo; ¿Cómo estás? Muy bien. D
Your child responds to Spanish classroom commands such as Formen un círculo, Levanten la mano, Siéntense, y Levántense.
Your child can identify most mascotas (pets). For example: perro, gato, pez, etc. Your child can successfully match the Spanish word to the correct animal image from <i>la granja</i> (farm). le: cerdo, pollo, vaca, etc.
Your child recognizes the phrase "Hay" and can use it with vocabulary to create a full sentence in Spanish. For example: Hay un tigre. There is a tiger. Hay cerdos. There are pigs. D I
Your child is familiar with various animals from la selva (jungle), & el mar (sea). For example: tigre, elefante, oso, tortuga, pájaro, mono, rana, etc.
When asked, your child can point to various parts of an animal such as <i>pelo</i> (hair), <i>plumas</i> (feathers), <i>nariz</i> (nose), <i>boca</i> (mouth), & <i>piernas</i> (legs).
Your child can successfully sing along entirely in Spanish to the theme song "Los animales." D Comments:
