*repeat using cloudy/nublado, raining/lloviendo, snowing/nevando, cold/frío, or hot/calor.

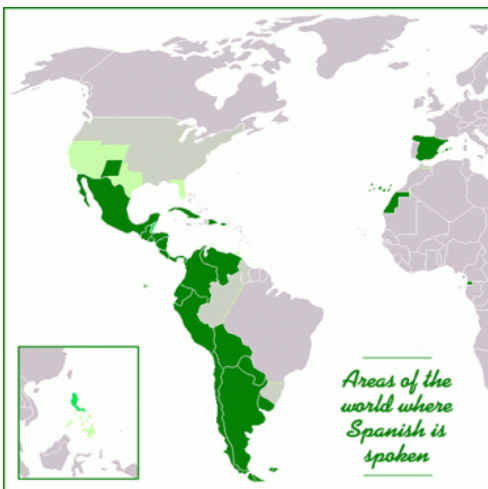
Days of the Week
