Hola means hello-hello-hello

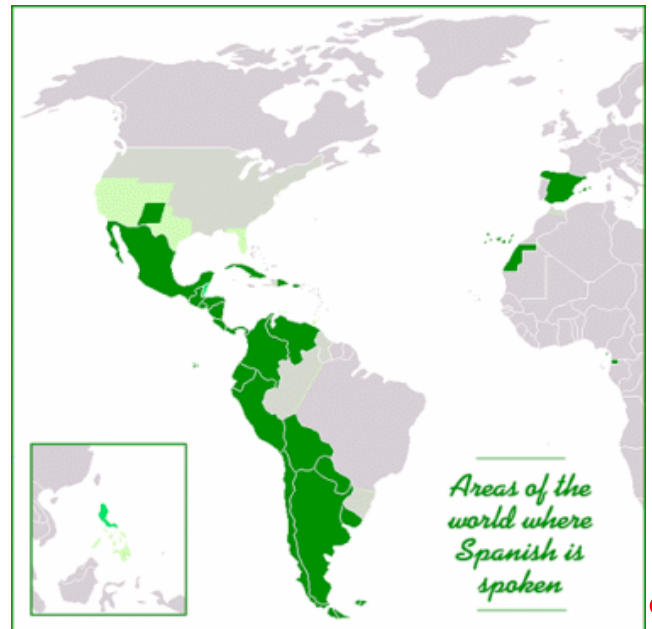
Hola means hello
