Today we learned how to say directions as well of locations of objects. With these new words and phrases we practiced using total conceptual learning using está. Our teacher would have an object and place it somewhere near a desk. The teacher would called out ¿Dónde está (article)(object)? We would then answer with (article)(object) está (location). Our teacher would move it each time so our answer would always change.

Example: ¿Dónde está el lapiz? (Where is the pencil?). El lapiz está encima del escritorio. The pencil is on top of the desk.

Class activities:

We are continuing to work on our labeling our "casas" We can now use not only adjectives to describe our casas, but we can also use directional words to describe where objects or rooms are in the house.

Grammar Lesson:

When you combine *de* and the article *el* in Spanish, you create a new word, *del*.

Examples: El lapiz está encima **del** escritorio. Está a la derecha **del** hospital.

Persona 1: ¿Dónde está la casa de tu tía?

Persona 2: Está a la derecha del hospital.

Translation:
Where is your aunt's house? It is
to the right of the hospital!
