All other time is said in the plural (*son las*) since there is more than one hour.

Notas Culturas

You might have noticed or heard that some Spaniards tend to say gracias by softly lisping the c (sounds like 'gra**th**ias' or 'Bar**th**elona') while in other parts of the Spanish-speaking world people pronounce the c as an s (sounds like 'grasias' or 'Bar-sell-ona'). Can you think of any areas in the United States that pronounce things differently than other areas?
