The Eliminator -

List a sequence of months on the board. Have the students say them out loud - with your help, if needed. Erase one word. Have the students say the whole list back. Keep erasing words one by one until all of the words are erased and the class knows the sequence of words.

Serpiente - Write the Spanish word for all of the months on 8x10" pieces of paper. Have one student pick out the name of a month and go stand in front of the classroom holding the name in front of him or herself. Then have another student pick another month. He or she will need to stand before or after this student, depending on when the month is. Keep doing this until all of the children are in front of the room. Have the left over students make sure they are in the right order. Then have each student say out loud what month they are. Link together and go around the room three times saying the names of the month in order. The "extra students" and the teacher will be the end of the snake and they will all shout, "¡Messssssssss- Serpiente!" when all of the months have been called.

Monthly calendar: Use the enclosed worksheet to create a monthly calendar on the first day. Fill in the blanks with the days (numbers) and say them out loud in Spanish. *Hint:* Start every day off with the students by asking them what day it is, what month it is, and what the temperature is. It is fun to have a thermometer, so they can actually read it and say the temperature.
