El Boquete, Panama is a popular tourist location, because of the beautiful mountains and lush countryside. There are also many things to do in El Boquete. For example: touring the rainforest, ziplining, and white water rafting. Bakeries are very popular in Panama. They serve bread (pan), pastries (pasteles), sandwiches (sandwiches), and soups (sopas). At Garden, a bakery (panadería) in Boquete, you can get a cinnamon bun and coffee for \$0.65 or an ice cream cone for \$0.25.
