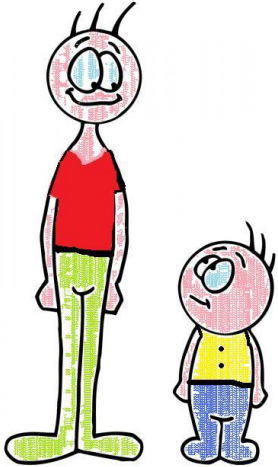


**Day 4- Optional Homework**
