Within the Andean village of Ayacucho you can see many artisans at work and purchase their handicrafts like: rugs, tapestries, and carpet. A specialty of the city is the etched *mates burilados* or gourds. Bartering is a common practice in Peru among the locals. The money in Peru is called the Nuevo Sol (commonly referred to just as sol). In Lima, Peru the US dollar is frequently used and accepted.
