

### What is a Rubric?

Rubric is a common term used in education. Many educators define a rubric in different ways. However, a common explanation is: a document that spells out or explains the expectations for an assignment (or project) by listing what items in the project will be counted as part of the grade and it also describes the levels of quality from excellent to poor. In summation a rubric is a guideline for how something will be grade. *Note: You should not spend an extensive amount of time working on rubrics. When in doubt, ask!*

*This rubric is designed to assess the presentation of the group activity. The rubric should consider the performance of the group as a whole, as well as individual contributions, and the work they did in class to achieve it. Create a skit in a Group of 4(1 Teacher and 3 students). You should a)greet each other b)ask names c)perform introductions d) say goodbye. Skit should last 4-5 minutes.*
