Grammar Note

Gusta is for singular objects.
Gustan is for plural objects.
The pronoun before the gusta conjugation is the subject pronoun.

For example:

me- *I*,
te- *you*,
le- *he/she/Usted*,
les- *they*,
nos- *we*



Notas Culturales / Class Activities

We discussed the popular sport and culture activity of bullfighting, which occurs primarily in Spain. Ask your students to tell you about this!

Students will continue to build on their skills, as well as learn new vocabulary such as: the verb conjugations of SER (to be), house vocabulary, singular adjectives, singular subject pronouns, along with review of verbs and sentence structure.
