Vocabulary List

Please practice vocabulary from past weeks' newsletters to review for the final class next week. Topics covered include: singular adjectives, verb conjugations of SER, transportation, great outdoors, singular subject pronouns, and time.

Patatas Bravas

(Potatoes with a spicy sauce) One of the most popular dishes in Spain! It is found in almost every tapas restaurant.

Ingredients:

2 lbs potatoes
2 Tbs olive oil for frying and for sauce
salt + paprika (spicy or sweet)
1 cup tomato sauce
1 TB red wine vinegar
1 clove garlic finely chopped
1/2 ts sweet Spanish paprika
1/2 ts spicy Spanish paprika (to taste)
salt to taste

Directions:

Heat the oil and (about 1 inch in the pan) peel & cut the potatoes into about 1" cubes. Add them to the oil and cook until golden (about 12-15 mins). Remove from the oil and place on a paper towel lined tray. Sprinkle with a salt and a dash of paprika if desired. To make the sauce, heat the oil and add the garlic. Cook for 1 minute and then add the tomato sauce. Add the vinegar & paprikas. Simmer for 5 minutes. Add salt and check for spiciness. Pour sauce over the hot potatoes and serve.

Notas Culturales / Class Activities

Today we talked about how meal times differ from country to country. In Spain, there are traditionally four meals daily. A light breakfast is eaten around 7:00am and lunch is served around noon. Lunch is the largest meal of the day- meat, vegetables, soup, salad, and dessert. Around 5-6 p.m., when people are hungry again, it is not uncommon to have a "merienda" which translates as a "snack." These small plates are often called tapas. Make a tapa at home together, like *Patatas Bravas* to the left!
