Tengo hambre, tengo hambre, tengo tanto hambre

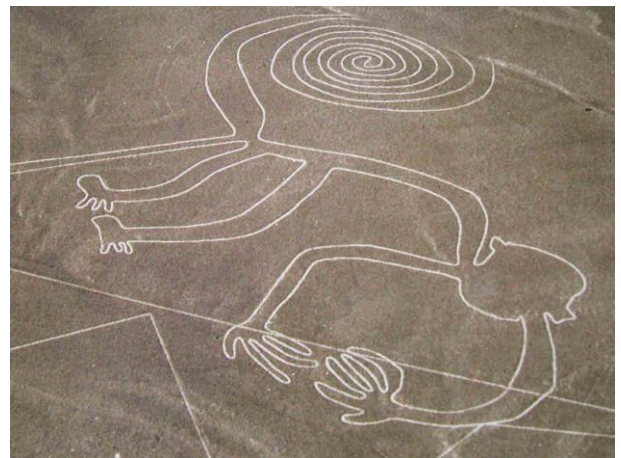
Me gusta la comida.
