Notas Culturales

Did you know that most schools in Latin America require that children wear uniforms even in public schools. Students in primary schools in Argentina typically wear knee length white smocks, similar to lab coats. This was a tradition that started in Spain, Italy, and France that was brought to Argentina. The purpose of the white smock was to cover the difference in clothing of the students so that poor children wouldn't be embarrassed by their poor clothing. Discuss the topic of school uniforms with your child and see if they would prefer to wear uniforms or not and why.
