Common phrases used in class today, but not necessarily vocabulary words:

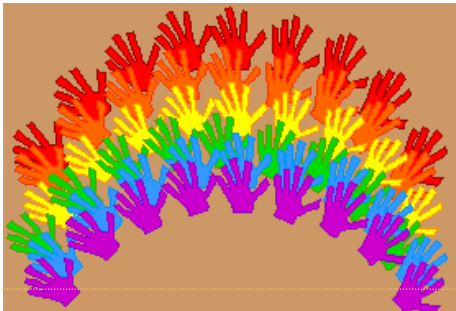
¿Dónde están? -Where are they?

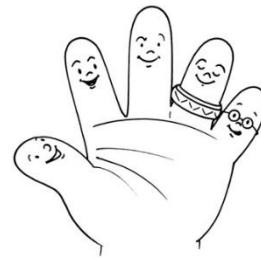


We encourage you to practice vocabulary at home with your children. They will remember much more!
