## Notas Culturales/Class Activities

Today we talked about tortillas. Many people in Spanish speaking countries eat tortillas with their meals. Often times they use the tortilla instead of a spoon to scoop rice and chicken. In some countries people even eat tortillas for breakfast with their eggs! The word "tortilla" means "little cake" in Spanish. See if your child likes tortillas by asking, "¿Te gusta la tortilla? Do you like the tortilla?"
