Any adjective, including a color, must agree with the noun in gender. For example: take the color red (rojo) it changes to *roja* when the noun is a feminine noun. See if you know whether to use *rojo* or *roja* to describe the nouns below.

Lupita lleva una falda_____.
Lupita tiene el pelo _____.
Lupita va a un restaurant_____.

**Even if you do not remember the meaning of the noun, you should be able to follow the general rule for agreement.*
