Today we continued working on telling time *en español!* One difference between telling time in Spanish versus English is time in the hour of 1 is singular (*es la*) since there is only one hour. All other time is said in the plural (*son las*) since there is more than one hour.

Notas Culturales

You might have noticed or heard that some Spaniards tend to say *gracias* by softly lisping the *c* (sounds like 'grathias' or 'Barthelona') while in other parts of the Spanish-speaking world people pronounce the *c* as an *s* (sounds like 'grasias' or 'Bar-sell-ona'). Can you think of any areas in the United States that pronounce things differently than other areas?
