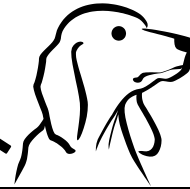




## **Paper Plate Gatos o Perros.**



### Materials

9" paper plate (2 per student)

Stapler

Crayons

Construction paper -variety of colors

Pipe cleaners

### **What next?**

- 1.) Staple the paper plates together, and give each child a "set".
- 2.) Remind the students what the words Perro y Gato mean.
- 3.) Ask the children which is their favorite.
- 4.) Have them color their plates to be that animal. (Review the colors in Español as you do this!)
- 5.) Remind them of the various face vocabulary words as they draw their faces.
- 6.) Have them cut two triangles out of construction paper to be ears. This is a great opportunity to review this vocabulary word!
- 7.) Paste the ears on the face of the animal.
- 8.) If a student is making a cat, you can help him or her add pipe cleaners for whiskers.
- 9.) Again, review the words Perro and Gato. Have the children repeat after you. You can write the Spanish word on the plate for the students so they can practice the word with their parents.
- 10.) Review-¿Cómo te llamas? Me llamo\_\_\_\_\_ and then have the children pretend to answer as if they were the animal.
- 11.) Have the children act out dogs and cats when you review the words one last time.
- 12.) Sing the Especial Song! Have fun!
