Notas Culturas & Class Activities

Even though Thanksgiving is only celebrated in the United States, it is fun to learn Spanish related to the holiday. In Spanish the holiday is called *El dia de Acción de Gracias*. Students should remember that *Gracias* is thank you in Spanish. In Spanish you can say *"Yo doy gracias por..."* to explain what you are thankful for. Here is a vocabulary list of responses: amor- love, comida-food, familia-family, amigos- friends, casa- house, hermanossiblings, juguetes- toys, animales- animals, cama- bed, escuela- school, dinero- money, juegos- games, dulces- sweets, salud- health, maestros- teachers.
