

Week 3 Optional Homework: Vamos a Jugar

Today we "visited" the beach (la playa). Play a simplified version of Pesca (Go fish) to review the words we learned. Cut out the picture cards below and shuffle them, distributing them evenly among the two players. Each player puts down any automatic matches. Then the players ask each other for matches by asking, "¿Tienes ___?" (Do you have...?) If the other player has the card, he or she hands it over. Otherwise the player responds, ¡Pesca! (Go fish) and the player then picks from his or her opponent's hand. The first player to get the most pairs—and say the words in Spanish—wins!
