


Day 1 Optional Homework: Vamos al Zoo

Use the new phrase "Hay\_(animal in Spanish)\_" to explain what animals there are in the zoo. Write all the words in Spanish next to the animals. Tip-Use your newsletter as a reference if you need help!



For younger students, tell a friend of family member what animals are in the zoo in Spanish using the phrase "Hay" and the Spanish vocabulary from class.

Pronunciation note: The "h" in "hay" is silent, so the word sounds more like "eye" in English.

Example: Hay elefantes. = There are elefants.

tigres, jirafas, cebras, leónes, gorillas, canguros, osos, monos, hipopótomos
