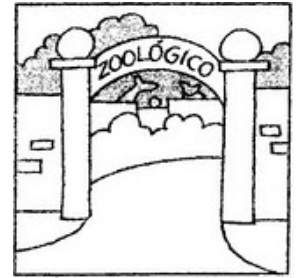


El zoológico

Dani and Beto explored *el zoológico* (the zoo) today. The animals below are just a few that can be found in the zoo. Use the new phrase “*Hay_(animal in Spanish)_*” to explain what animals there are in the zoo. Write all the words in Spanish next to the animals. Tip- Use your newsletter as a reference if you need help!



For younger students, tell a friend or family member what animals are in the zoo in Spanish using the phrase “*Hay*” and the Spanish vocabulary from class. Pronunciation note: The “h” in “*hay*” is silent, so the word sounds more like “eye” in English.

Example: *Hay elefantes.* = There are elephants.

tigres, jirafas, cebras, leones, gorillas, canguros, osos, monos, hipopótomos

***The next time you go to the zoo bring along the words in Spanish and try finding the animals and practicing their names in Spanish- like a scavenger hunt!
