


Práctica

Your child is learning valuable connectors phrases this semester that will allow for easy building of complete sentences in Spanish.

Below you will find various sentences using the valuable phrase ¿Dónde está? (Where is or Where are?) or *Muéstrame* (Show me).

Read the sentence aloud and then have your child draw a line to the part of the image and write the English translation.

Parents: If your child is a non-reader then simply read the sentence to your child and have him or her point to the image or give the English translation. You may need to use a visual or physical cue since this vocabulary is brand new.

3. ¿Dónde están las manos?
4. ¿Dónde está la camisa?
5. ¿Dónde están las piernas? ——

6. Muéstrame abajo.
