<i>¿Necesitamos reservar una mesa en el restaurante del hotel?</i>	Do we need to reserve a table at the hotel restaurant?
<i>¿Debemos alquilar un auto o podemos usar un taxi?</i>	Do we need to rent a car or can we use a taxi?
<i>¿Podría llamarme a un taxi?</i>	Can you call me a cab?
<i>¿A dónde se dirige?</i>	Where are you going?
<i>¿Puede darme otra toalla?</i>	Can you give me another towel?
