<p><b>Tema:</b> El Mes de la Herencia Hispana</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>MÚSICA LATINA:</b> begin the class with some Latin music to set the mood for your class! Instrumental, with words, karaoke style, etc. <b>NOTE:</b> always double check that the songs your play are kid friendly, listening to the songs prior to the lesson or looking for the lyrics is always a good idea. Heritage students will notice any inappropriate words first!</li> <li>• <b>INTRODUCING HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH: Grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ Ask how many students have heard or know what Hispanic Heritage Month is about.
