## Mi viaje a La Ciudad de México

For this project, you will be planning a trip to La Ciudad de México (Mexico City)! You will be bringing one family member, friend, or pet. You will be using Google Slides to write your itinerary for your trip (completely *en español!*). You will be using the following information to write your itinerary:

- el vocabulary de *los lugares de la comunidad*
- actual sites in Mexico City
- el verbo IR (*to go*)
- ir + a + place (Ejemplos: *Yo voy **al** museo. Nosotros vamos **a la** panadería.*)
- ir + a + infinitive (Ejemplos: *Yo voy **a** comer los tacos. Ella va **a** ver el arte.*)

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Use the following guidelines to complete your project:

### Slide #1:

Include the following:

- the title: **Mi viaje a La Ciudad de México**
- a picture of Mexico City
- a map showing where Mexico City is located
- your name



### Slide #2:

**ANSWER** the following questions in Spanish:

¿Adónde vas? (*Where are you going?*)

¿Con quién vas? (*With whom are you going?*)

¿Cómo van Uds.? (*How are you all getting there?*)

Include some **pictures or visuals** to make this page more interesting.





### **Slides #3-10:**

For EACH slide, write **TWO** sentences. You will be answering these questions on each slide:

¿Adónde vas? (*Where are you going?*) HINT: Use **ir + a + place**

¿Qué vas a hacer? (*What are you going to do?*) HINT: Use **ir + a + infinitive**

Assume that you and your travel companion do not always want to do the same things. Sometimes you do things together, and sometimes you will split up. Therefore, some of the slides will use the pronoun **yo**, some will use **él or ella**, and some will use **nosotros or nosotras**. Make sure you include a variety of pronouns throughout your project.

For Slides #3-10, you should include **at least one picture** of the place you are visiting.

**gastar dinero** *to spend money*

**hablar** *to talk*

**leer** *to read*

**mirar** *to watch*

**nadar** *to swim*

**probar** *to try; to sample*

**sacar fotos** *to take pictures*

**subir** *to climb, go up*

**tomar un café** *to drink coffee*

**ver** *to see*

**visitar** *to visit*

Note that some of these infinitive sentences will require additional vocabulary in order to make sense.

Example:

**Yo voy a ver.**

*I am going to see. (Going to see what??)*

**Yo voy a ver el arte.**

*I am going to see the art.*
