



Vamos a Comer~ Menu Proyecto: La carta

This is a suggested project that students can complete in the last 3-4 classes of the Vamos a Comer class. Based on your group, you can use 5-10 minutes during the class period for your students to work on it. Typically, the end of class works best! Students can work individually or in pairs on this project.

- Be sure to **provide a blank piece of paper** to your students so they can work in their Spanish menu creation. *Keep these with you so they can work on them with you each week until they are complete.

-Students will be creating a “picture menu” using the vocabulary we have learned in class. Set out the picture flashcards on the tables to help with labeling and walk around while they work to help as needed.

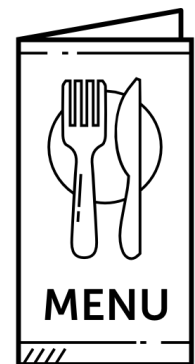
- Students will draw, color, add price and label the food items in Spanish. You will need to help them with the labeling. Encourage students to have fun creating this project with colorful drawings and lots of creativity!

Project Instructions:

Make a **COVER** for the menu that includes the name of their restaurant. Your restaurant’s name should be written in Spanish. Use your creativity to decorate it!

Encourage the students to include different sections in their menu. Use the word bank provided to help you organize all the items under the right section. Each item on your menu should include a **drawing** in color and can also include a price in dollars (\$).

Menu Sections:
El desayuno (breakfast) -include 3 food items and a drink
El almuerzo (lunch) -include 3 food items and a drink
La merienda (snack) y el postre (dessert)
La cena (dinner) -include 3 food items and a drink



*Skit~ On the last class have students show their menus to the class. They can act out restaurant skits with simple conversation they’ve learned in class with the menus. Send their work home for parents to see.
