tú	you (informal)	vosotros/as (in Spain)	you all (informal)
él	he	ellos	they (all males or males and females together)
ella	she	ellas	they (all females)
usted	you (formal)	ustedes	you all (formal)

- Tú** (You informal) is used for people you have confidence in or your same age.
- Usted** (You Formal) for people older than you or to show respect (your doctor, a priest, your boss, etc.)
- Ellos** is used for: They boys and They boys and girls
- Ellas** is used just for girls (they girls).

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- **Vosotros** (you all informal) is used only in Spain. The **ustedes** (you all formal) form is used everywhere else.

D – Description (physical characteristics) tall, blond, brunette

O – Origin/Nationality (from Mexico, Mexican)

C – Characteristics (personality) (shy, outgoing, funny)
