Español Conversacional para Principiantes - Day 6

1. Ice Breakers & Get to know each other conversation practice to get started.

- Invite your students to introduce themselves to the class in Spanish, encourage them to share describe where are you (include a place in the community). **¿Dónde estás?** Where are you? (Include place/places in the community) *Goal to encourage participants to speak/practice Spanish. Remember that students may have different levels in the Spanish language, so feel free to screen share the PowerPoint visual with the Q&A or use the whiteboard. *You could also use the [FLASHCARDS](#) available in Futura's portal as visuals for today's lesson.
- **Important:** provide a clear and consistent bilingual approach with Spanish first (slow and enunciated) and English translations to help participants follow along.

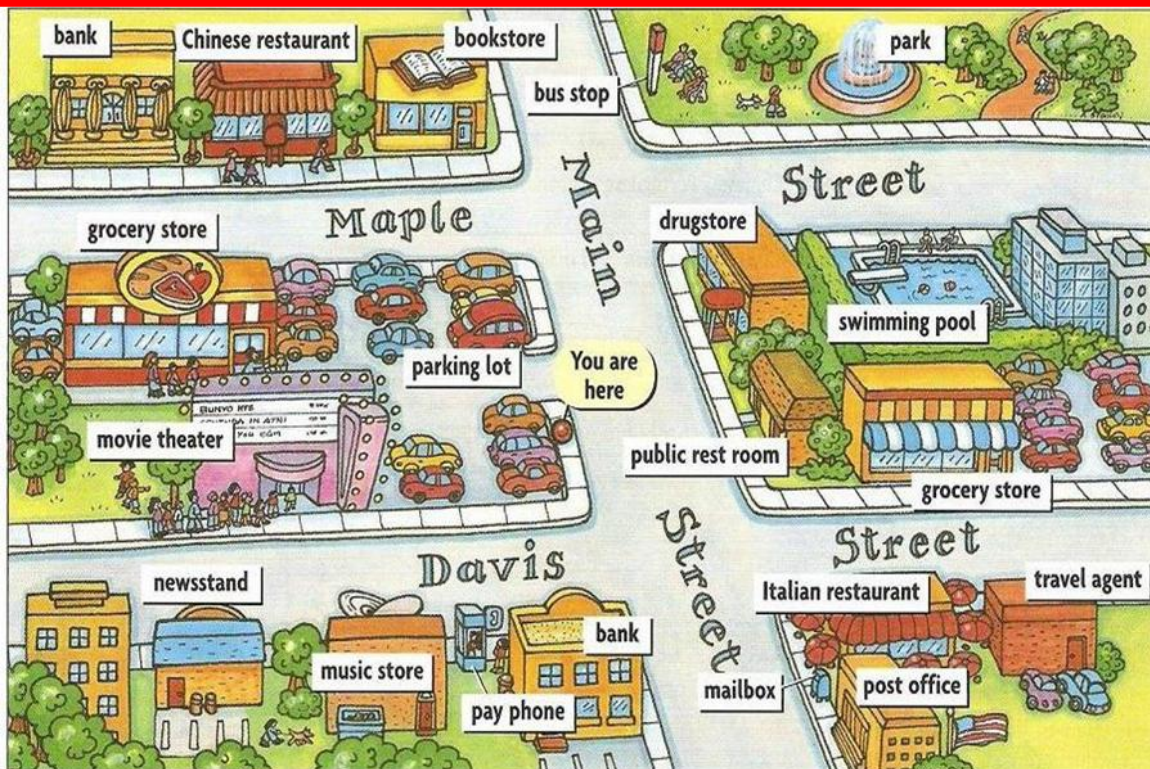

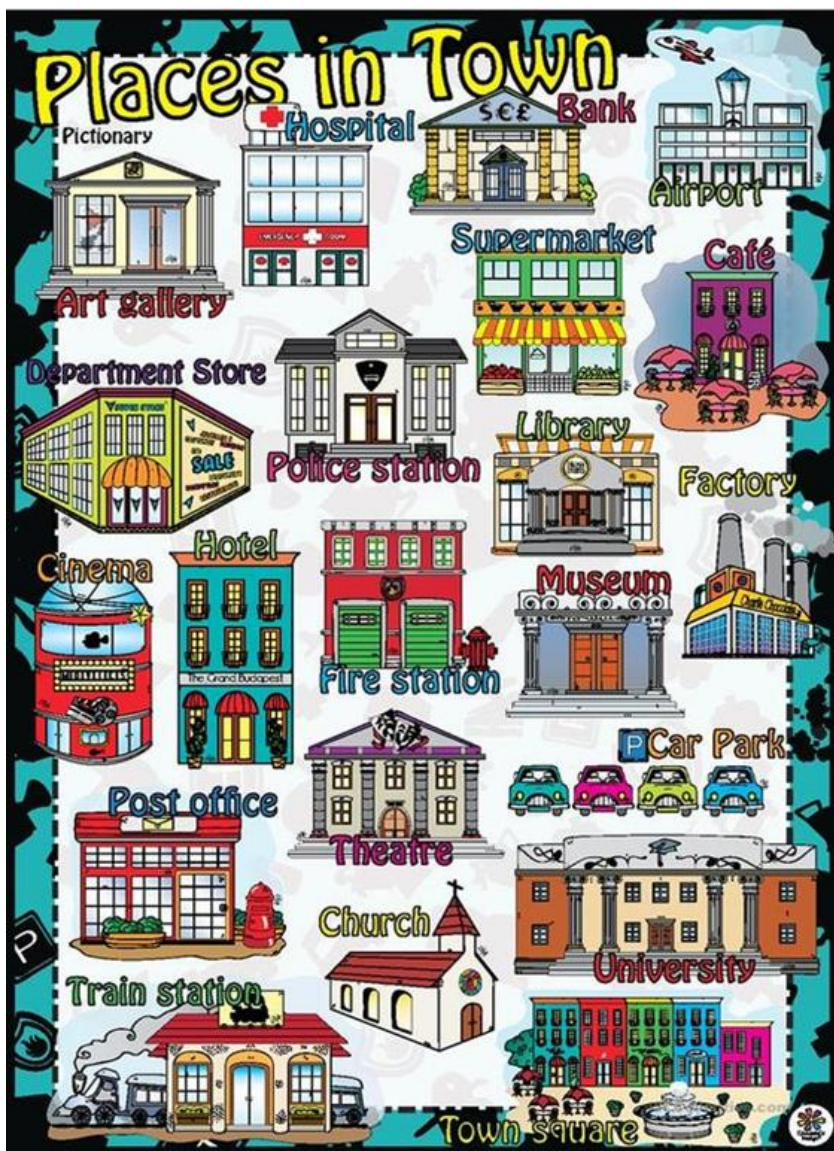
