

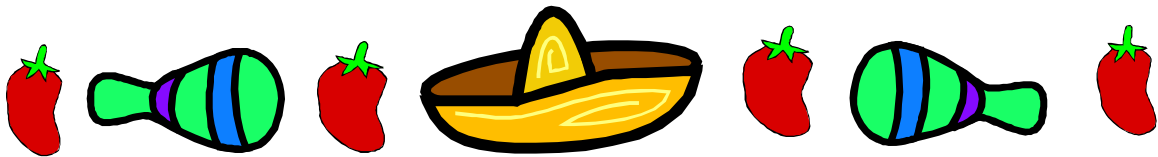


### Craft Suggestion:

## LET'S MAKE UN MILAGRO

*Milagros Are Words for the Future* is a countrywide project for Latino children. Children are encouraged to make icons, called milagros, which show their wishes and goals for the future. Help your students make un milagro.

**Materials:** Construction paper, scissors, glue, markers, crayons, glitter, buttons, fabric scraps, and ribbon, photographs of the children (optional.)



Discuss with the children the significance of un milagro and encourage each child to design his or her own.

Children can shape the milagro by cutting the construction paper any way they would like.

The students can chose to glue a photograph or draw a picture of themselves on the front of the milagro. They may wish to add decorations to the front, as well.

Ask students to write a wish for the future on the back. (The younger children may need help with their writing.) Help children make a hole on the top of the milagro and tie a string for hanging. Have the children label their Milagros with mi nombre, mi milagro, y la fecha.

These make nice decorations for the last class!
