**5. Vocabulary #2. GRAMÁTICA: Present Perfect Tense.** *Vamos a aprender acerca del presente perfecto en español.* We are going to learn about present perfect tense.



**El Presente Perfect.** Click on this [YouTube video](#) to learn about the conjugation of irregular verbs in the present perfect.

To express past tense in Spanish “easily,” use the “present perfect” tense. In English, this is the “to have done something” tense. This is known as a compound tense with the auxiliary verb **HABER** plus the past participle. The past participle does not change for gender or number in the compound tenses.

For example:

*He comido. I have eaten. He dormido. I have slept. He trabajado. I have worked.*

In Spanish, use:

**A.** The verb **HABER** = to have “done”

### Verbo **HABER** – To have done

Singular		Plural	
he (eh)	I have	hemos (ehmos)	we have
has (ahs)	you have (informal)	habéis (ah-bays)	you all have (informal) *Only in Spain
ha (ah)	he has she has you have (formal)	han (ahn)	they have you all have

**B.** The verb you are trying to express in the past tense. (You need to change the ending a bit, depending on if it ends in -AR, -ER, or -IR.)

AR Verbs	ER Verbs	IR Verbs
bailar → bail <u>ado</u>	comer → com <u>ido</u>	vivir → viv <u>ido</u>
hablar → habl <u>ado</u>	leer → le <u>ído</u>	ir → <u>ido</u>
mirar → mir <u>ado</u>	beber → beb <u>ido</u>	decidir → decid <u>ido</u>

So, all together, you have:

**He bailado.** = I have danced.

**Hemos hablado.** = We have spoken.

**Has comido.** = You have eaten.

**Habéis decidido.** = You all have decided.

**Ha decidido.** = He has decided.

**¿Han leído?** = Have they read?

<b>A:</b> ¡Suena divertido! Yo <b>he esquiado</b> una vez y <b>he surfado</b> dos veces en la playa.	<b>A:</b> That sounds fun! <b>I have skied</b> once and <b>I have surfed</b> twice at the beach.
<b>B:</b> ¡Qué genial! ¿Alguna vez <b>has boxeado</b> o <b>has competido</b> en un deporte?	<b>B:</b> How cool! <b>Have you ever boxed</b> or <b>competed</b> in a sport?
<b>A:</b> Sí, <b>he competido</b> en carreras locales, pero nunca <b>he boxeado</b> .	<b>A:</b> Yes, <b>I have competed</b> in local races, but <b>I have never boxed</b> .
<b>B:</b> Hablando de competencias, ¿ <b>has visto los juegos Olímpicos</b> este año?	<b>B:</b> Speaking of competitions, <b>have you watched the Olympic Games</b> this year?
<b>A:</b> Sí, <b>he visto los juegos Olímpicos</b> y <b>he admirado a los atletas</b> . Ellos <b>han ganado la medalla</b> después de mucho esfuerzo.	<b>A:</b> Yes, <b>I have watched the Olympic Games</b> and <b>I have admired the athletes</b> . They <b>have won the medal</b> after a lot of effort.
<b>B:</b> Es verdad. Yo también <b>he visto la antorcha</b> en la inauguración y <b>he aprendido mucho</b> sobre los deportes.	<b>B:</b> That's true. <b>I have also seen the torch</b> at the opening ceremony, and <b>I have learned a lot</b> about sports.
<b>A:</b> Los deportes son increíbles. ¡Definitivamente <b>hemos practicado</b> muchas actividades interesantes!	<b>A:</b> Sports are amazing. We have definitely practiced many interesting activities!
