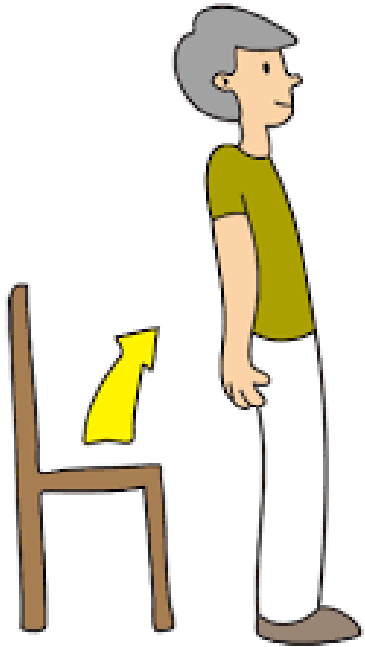

1. Greetings Song

- Begin class by singing a greetings song together, encouraging students to participate with gestures and actions.

2. Classroom Commands

- Use simple commands such as *levántense* and *siéntense* to practice listening and establish classroom routines.

3. Vocabulary Review

- Review key vocabulary using flashcards, Quizlet, or Wordwall while incorporating gestures and TPR to reinforce meaning and comprehension.

4. Interactive Review Activity – For example: ¡Vasos Sorpresa!

- Engage students in a fun, interactive review activity that gets them moving, speaking, and practicing the target vocabulary with different partners.

5. Attention Getter & Regrouping

- Use a simple attention-getting pattern to bring students back together and transition to the next part of the lesson.

6. Closing Routine

- End class with a goodbye song or a familiar farewell routine to provide a consistent and positive ending to the lesson.
