In this project, you will use Spanish verbs, vocabulary, and complete sentences to create a Google Slides presentation about an animal of your choice. You will practice:

- -AR, -ER, and -IR verbs
- Describing animals
- Using **complete sentences**
- Using the **present progressive tense** (is doing / is not doing)

You will also include **images** to help show what your animal looks like and does.

Animal Project Outline (Google Slides)

SLIDE 1: INTRODUCTION

- Include an image of your animal.
- Write **4 complete sentences in Spanish**:
 - Introduce your animal
 - Give your animal a name
 - Tell where your animal lives
 - Tell how old your animal is (**write out the number**)



Example structure:

Mi animal es... / Se llama... / Vive en... / Tiene... años.

SLIDE 2: WHAT YOUR ANIMAL EATS

- Include images of food.
- Write **6 complete sentences in Spanish**:
 - **3 sentences** about what your animal likes to eat
 - **3 sentences** about what your animal does not like to eat
- Use verbs like *comer* and *beber*
- Use *le gusta* / *no le gusta*

SLIDE 3: DESCRIBING YOUR ANIMAL

- Include close-up images or labeled images.
- Write **6 complete sentences in Spanish**:
 - **4 sentences** describing what your animal **is** (color, size, body parts, personality, etc.)
 - **2 sentences** describing what your animal **is not**
- Use adjectives
- Remember adjective agreement (masculine/feminine, singular/plural)

SLIDE 4: WHAT YOUR ANIMAL IS DOING

- Include action images.
- Write **8 complete sentences in Spanish**:
 - **4 sentences** telling what your animal **is doing**
 - **4 sentences** telling what your animal **is not doing**
- Use the **present progressive tense** (*está* + verb ending in *-ando* / *-iendo*)

Examples:

- *Está corriendo.*
- *No está durmiendo.*

PROJECT REMINDERS

- All writing must be in **complete Spanish sentences**
- Check **capitalization, spelling, and punctuation**
- Use **clear images** that match your sentences
- Be creative and have fun showing what your animal can do
